

## Typical Activities

The following is a list of the different types of activities your child will be a part of while at pre-school.

**Circle Time** - Students will say the Pledge of Allegiance. There will be discussion about the calendar, season, weather, and "Letter of the Week." The Special Child for the day will share his/her show-and-tell item(s).

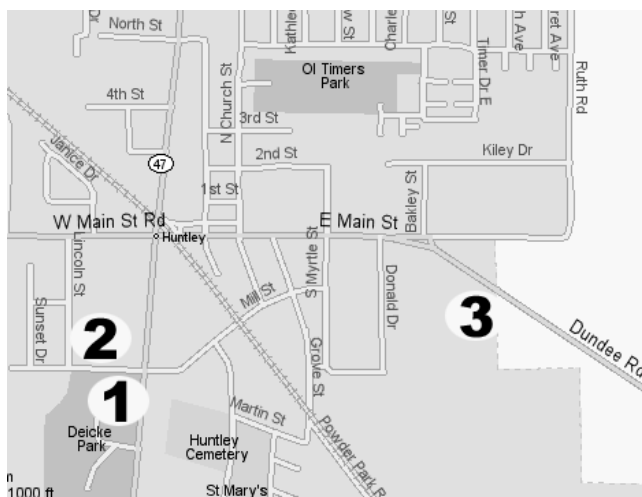
**Centers** - Centers could consist of some of the following: Letter of the week project, science project, group game, enhancement of fine motor skills, cooking, painting, coloring, cutting, social development, etc.

**Music** - Once every two weeks, a member from Kid Rock will lead the children in songs, dancing, and the playing of musical instruments. Sessions from Kid Rock will focus on animals, the season, holidays, and other fun themes. Kid Rock flyers are available in the lobby of the pre-school.

**Snack Time** - The "Special Child of the day" is responsible for bringing treats for the day. Parents need to supply something to drink and eat for each student in the classroom.

**Large Motor Skills** - Playtime is used to encourage the use of large motor skills. Children will be able to take advantage of the indoor and/or outdoor structures and facilities during playtime.

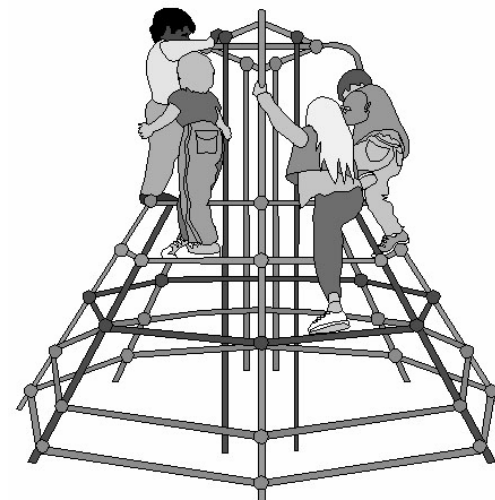

Our facilities are located in beautiful Deicke Park, Huntley North School, and Huntley Tech Center. All of the classrooms are clean, safe, bright and cheery. We offer a variety of toys, equipment, books, and learning materials. The classrooms encourage constructive interactions with play materials and offer an atmosphere where your child can get to know and play with other children. Our indoor and

outdoor play centers offer a variety of structures to enhance large motor skills.

Our curriculum is developmentally appropriate for the young child. It provides opportunities for problem solving, physical activity, self-initiated activities, teacher directed group activities, and other challenges.

Seedlings offers a variety of special event days for the children. Some of those days and events include:

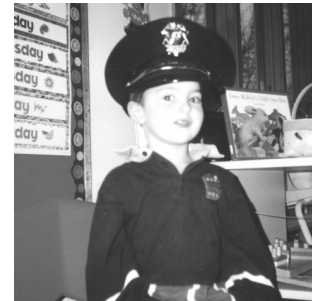
- Halloween Party
